10 HIDDEN GEMS IN PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND



1 Victoria-by-the-Sea

Charming seaside village with shops, art galleries, cafés and stunning harbour views.



2 Basin Head Provincial Park

Famous for its “Singing Sands” and beautiful white-sand beach. Great for swimming and picnics.



3 Point Prim Lighthouse

PEI’s oldest lighthouse (1845) with panoramic coastal views and rich maritime history.



4 Orwell Corner Historic Village

Step back into the 1890s. Explore historic buildings, watch demonstrations and meet friendly interpreters.



5 Panmure Island Beach

Long, quiet beach with soft sand, shallow water and nearby historic lighthouse. Perfect for a relaxing day.



6 Greenwich Dunes

Scenic boardwalk through dunes and wetlands leading to a breathtaking beach.



7 St. Peters Bay

Picturesque harbour village with fresh seafood, shops and water activities.



8 North Cape

Where the Gulf meets the Strait. Stunning views, lighthouse and boardwalk.



9 Murray Harbour

Traditional fishing village with colourful boats, local eats and coastal charm.



10 Souris

Beautiful waterfront town with beaches, shops and ferry to the Îles de la Madeleine.
